

**Perinton Congregations for Flower City Habitat for Humanity
EMP Report March 2, 2020**

We're building our Eighth Home in 2020 at 79 Lime Street, Rochester, a three-bedroom colonial with one-and-a-half bathrooms. The new home will be in the JOSANA neighborhood where Flower City Habitat will complete its 100th home this year. This fulfills Habitat's pledge to the City of Rochester to revitalize the area with at least 100 new homes. This commitment to the JOSANA neighborhood was inspired by the shooting death of ten-year-old Tyshaun Cauldwell in 2001. The new homeowner is a single-mother of a three-year-old boy. She will invest at least 300 hours of "sweat equity" in her new home, working with the volunteers from the Perinton faith community. She'll also pay an affordable monthly mortgage for her new home.

Easy online registration: Soon we'll be recruiting volunteer builders to start work in mid-June through the fall. Registration is easy. Volunteers will be able to click on a link on our website. This is a great opportunity for all EMP churches to help, even if they haven't been involved in fundraising. It's a good idea to designate someone in your church to serve as a contact person and to help invite parishioners to volunteer to help build the house.

Groundbreaking Ceremony is Saturday, May 16, 10 a.m. Please join us and invite your parishioners.

This home is dedicated to the memory of Ron Hirschler who lead parishioners of St. John of Rochester Church in building a Habitat home on Cuba place in 1999 and he was an active member of the Perinton Habitat Steering Committee for over 20 years.
