Treasurer's report: Dan reviewed the attached Treasurer's report.

Received since last meeting:

- \$900 contribution from First Congregational Church
- \$12,500 contribution from St. John of Rochester

The first payment was made to Flower City Habitat for Humanity on May 7 for \$21,666.

Total available is \$58,991.

Flower City Habitat for Humanity volunteer registration page setup: There are two ways to connect to the calendar. One will require a password, which will be the same for everybody. The other way is to use our own link; no password needed. Volunteers will be able to see the work being done on the day they sign up for. Ken can run a weekly report for us to show who is signed up. Volunteers will be needed 1-3 days per week (no longer Tuesday through Saturday) and 5-20 volunteers will be needed each day (instead of the previous setup of 6 per day). New this year is a wait list option.

Ken will create a campaign page, the first week of shifts as a test, and making reservations with and without a password and email them to Mark and Rick.

Promoting volunteer signup: Mountain Rise would like to block out two weeks so their volunteers can work together; dates to be determined. Assumption and Resurrection will be working together to recruit volunteers. Perinton Presbyterian is still working it out.
