It is our understanding that EMP has monies dedicated for new ministries. As a relatively new EMP ministry we respectfully ask your consideration of the following.......

Background:

For the past 2 years, PMUNY has successfully fulfilled its mission to provide spiritual and financial support enabling Christian volunteers to follow Jesus' directive to visit the imprisoned as stated in Mt. 25:16. By bringing Jesus' Good News of love, healing and reconciliation to incarcerated adults and teens, hope lives and lives are transformed.

Currently, we have over 130 volunteers providing Residents Encounter Christ retreats in medium and maximum security men's prisons in Upstate New York. These facilities include: Attica, Auburn, Groveland, Livingston and Wende. In addition we sponsor the Fully Alive program at Albion (women's facility) and the Houses of Healing (adults) and Power Source (teens) programs in the Monroe County Jail. We estimate that approximately 400 incarcerated individuals in Upstate New York are benefitting from our ministry.

In addition, PMUNY is currently working with two chaplains interested in offering the Residents Encounter Christ Retreat in their facilities for the first time. We hope to get these programs off the ground in the next year and expect other facilities may be interested as well.

Needs/Challenges:

- Our need to recruit committed, trained and reliable volunteers continues. We want to collaborate with a local college/university marketing intern who will help us develop a marketing plan with viable strategies allowing us to systematically and effectively tell our story to area church groups in hopes of recruiting dedicated teams of new volunteers and receiving prayerful and financial donations.
- We are hoping to develop, print and provide quality written materials to reinforce the spiritual teachings offered in each of the programs we support. Printing costs for REC booklets is estimated at approximately \$4.00 per copy. Printing costs for Houses of Healing & Power Source workbooks are estimated at approximately \$2.00 per copy.

Any financial assistance EMP is prepared to give PMUNY as a ministry in it's 3rd year would be most appreciated.
