

QUARTERLY REPORT June 5, 2023 Submitted by: Joyce

- 1. **Recent Ministry Efforts** Programs continue at what feels like a snail's pace inside our correctional facilities.
 - Fully Alive- is "on hold" due to staffing issues related to filling a chaplaincy position at Albion.
 - Houses of Healing (HOH)— our second 13-week face to face program at Attica was cancelled and Making Time Count (MTC) a13 week self-study program was launched in its place. MTC will run from May-July 2023 involving 3-4 PMUNY volunteers meeting monthly in person with the group of incarcerated individuals while the men work on their own for the 13 weeks. The group consists of approximately 10 new participants and 5 "PALs". PALs are men who have completed the full 13-week HOH program and want to serve as "inside facilitators". "PAL" stands for "Peer Assistant Leaders". We continue to await final approval for a 13-week face to face Houses of Healing program in Groveland.
 - Residents Encounter Christ "RECs" were held at:
 Marana, Arizona- January 2023-12 residents & 10 outside volunteer team members

Attica-May 2023- 36 residents & 18 outside volunteer team members

Auburn & Groveland are currently "on hold" due to staffing shortages related to vacant chaplaincy positions. We are exploring holding retreat in "new" facilities including one scheduled for Fall 2023 at Wyoming CF.

Wende is scheduled for Fall 2023

- 2. **Volunteer Recruitment and Training -** We are delighted to be in the process of training approximately 7 new community volunteers to serve as future HOH facilitators.
- 3. **Celebration of Ramadan** I received an invitation from 2 Muslim chaplains (Attica and Groveland) to participate in a Ramadan Iftar at the Turkish Cultural Center (2692 Dewey Avenue) on April 1, 2023. It was a delightful multicultural and interfaith community experience!

4. Current Works in Progress:

- Identification & listing of Reentry Support services for inclusion on our website to assist individuals recently released from prison and to forward communications received from currently incarcerated individuals seeking supportive materials.
- Development of a Master Calendar in order to launch our endeavors in a timelier fashion geared to garner better communication and collaboration with all EMP faith communities and prison chaplains

5. Financial Update
