**Construction update:**

- **Construction** is past the halfway point and the house is looking good. Carlee reported that last Saturday they installed most of the siding on the sides and back and some on the front. Ethel said additional volunteer work opportunities will be scheduled for January.
- **Online volunteer registration** is working well. Perinton Presbyterian reserved November 13, St. John of Rochester reserved December 18, and “Friends and Family Day” for the owner is November 20. All other workdays are open.
- **Dedication** is tentatively scheduled for early to mid-February but that depends on several factors. Ethel said Flower City Habitat would print the programs in consultation with us and livestream it for those who can’t attend in person. The link to a recent dedication ceremony is posted on the Flower City website. Father Peter of St. John of Rochester would like to participate in the dedication if his schedule permits. Please consult your clergy staff to see if he/she/they would like to participate.

**Treasurer’s report:** Dan reviewed the attached Treasurer’s report and noted that we’ll have a reserve of over \$28,000 for our ninth Habitat home. That is due in part to some churches continuing to contribute annually while we delayed construction a year due to COVID issues.
