I will be meeting with 4 nursing students from St. John Fisher College next week. They will be offering 16 hours each, this will be a huge help for us! They also will be working with us to come up with a project that their group can do to support our CCH in some way.

I will be attending the University of Rochester: Panel Comfort Home/Hospice Event for HOPE Edu event on Monday, February 13th. The **HOPE Edu** student organization is a student group focused on learning and experience in hospice and comfort care. This will provide an opportunity to share about our work and organization and help students catch a vision for how they might be involved with us in this mutual area of interest.

I am looking forward to helping with the Gala this year and working on hard on encouraging friends and family to come as well.
