Programs and Activities Completed

Recruitment

We have successfully added two new youth members to our Board of Directors - one student is from the Fairport school district and one student is from Victor Schools. STSROC continues to seek to diversify its board through representation from several local school districts. Recruitment both for the Board and general volunteer team continues, but is challenging at this time.

University of Rochester - Visit to Youth In-Patient Program

STSROC is planning to donate items to the program that will contribute positively to the In-Patient experience. In November a representative from the U of R unit attended our Board meeting and shared with us their needs. We are currently planning the purchasing logistics, again difficult at this time!

Visioning for the Future

On Veterans Day we held an extended daytime meeting to plan for our future, specifically the events we will work to plan for 2021, in light of COVID 19. It was a great time of brainstorming new ways of engaging and supporting our community. As with so many organizations whose mission relies on in-person events 2020 has been a challenge!

May Media Challenge

STSROC issued a social media challenge to our followers. We asked each person to connect with 3 people, checking in on how they are doing mentally. These 'check-ins' were to be more than surface conversations. Followers were to then report that they had completed the task. Each report back to STSROC will translate into \$1 being given by STSROC to National Alliance on Mental Illness - NAMI Rochester. STSROC set a \$2000 limit for this challenge and final donation was \$700+.

Upcoming Programming and Activities

Operational Update

- Finance update as of November 1 reported by Marie Kamp - \$12,313. It is our plan to donate \$2000 of these funds to the University of Rochester. Our last large influx of funds was from the Church of Assumption Pasta Dinner (over \$2000) and Mountain Rise UCC's annual donation (\$250).
- We are currently switching our website and all document storage to a Google Suite account. This is a paid account (\$12 per month) and allows for much more functionality.
- We continue to work to recruit new members.
